Poultry Flock Handbook Available From State

Diseases-the cuase of most concern in the poultry businessmay originate in a flock in three different ways, according to a "Poultry Health Handbook" published by The Pennsylvania State University College of Agriculture.

"Diseases are brought on the farm with new poultry, contamination as a result of carryover from previous flocks, and are introduced by a lack of sanitation or relaxation of security measures," said Dr. L. Dwight Schwartz, Penn State Extension veterinarian and author of the publication.

The handbook is designed to provide poultrymen, servicemen, fieldmen, and hatcherymen with a ready and accessible source of . information about poultry diseases and other aspects of poultry health.

"The introductory section includes such information as a sanitation outline, list of reliable disinfectants, a description of the Pennsylvania Vaccination Program, and other facts useful for creating and maintaining sound poultry health programs, Dr. Schwartz points out.


Discount items for sale in the store will include clothing and other textiles, shoes, refinished and reupholstered furniture, household goods, and toys. Door prizes and balloons will be

Proceeds from sales at the various Goodwill stores go toward paying the wages of the




