Slaughter steers 1.00-1.50 lower and heifers 1.50-2.00 lower. Cows closed 2.00-3.00 lower. Bulls strong to 1.00 higher. Small feeder supply 1.00-2.00 lower, mainly fleshy two-way steers.

Four day receipts 23,200 as compared 20,600 previous week and 21,600 a year ago. Slaughter steers approximately 47 percent, heifers 30 percent, cows 5 percent, and feeders 11 percent.

STEERS: On Wednesday, two loads high-Choice and Prime 1152-1156 pounds yield grade 3-4 49.50, load same grade 1240 carrying considerable mud 48.50. Choice 1000-1250 2-4 closed 48.00-49.25, two loads 1110-1186 with few Prime 49.50; 1250-1350 3-4 46.75-48.00, load near 1400 4-5 46.00 Wednesday. Mixed Good and Choice 975-1250 47.00-48.25. 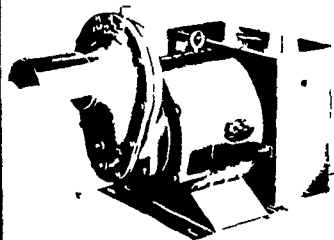
