

Rutt Heads Inter-State Young Dairymen

Dairy farmers, ages of 21 to 35, representing four states, met in Lancaster recently to discuss problems concerning their future life as dairy farmers.

Kenneth M. Rutt, Quarryville, Pa., was elected chairman for 1974 of this select group of young dairymen who are members of Inter-State Milk Producers' Cooperative, and serve as a Young Cooperator

Consultant Committee, directed by Inter-State's Board of Directors. Elected vice chairman was Clifford L. Higgs, Henderson, Md., and re-elected secretary was John J. Hess, Gettysburg, Pa.

George R. Brumbaugh, chairman of the Membership Relations Committee of Inter-State's Board of Directors, met with the fifteen-member Committee

and their wives during the all-day session.

Dr. James E. Honan, general manager, was the highlight of the program as he explained Inter-State's operations and answered questions presented by the young dairymen.

Inter-State Milk Producers' Cooperative represents some 2900 dairy farmers in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware,

Maryland, Virginia and West Virginia.

Chairman Rutt announced Young Cooperator Day for the three cooperatives who are members of Pennmarva Dairymen's Cooperative Federation - Inter-State Milk Producers' Cooperative, Maryland Cooperative Milk Producers, and Maryland & Virginia Milk Producers Association - to be held at Hunt Valley, Maryland, June

27, 1974.

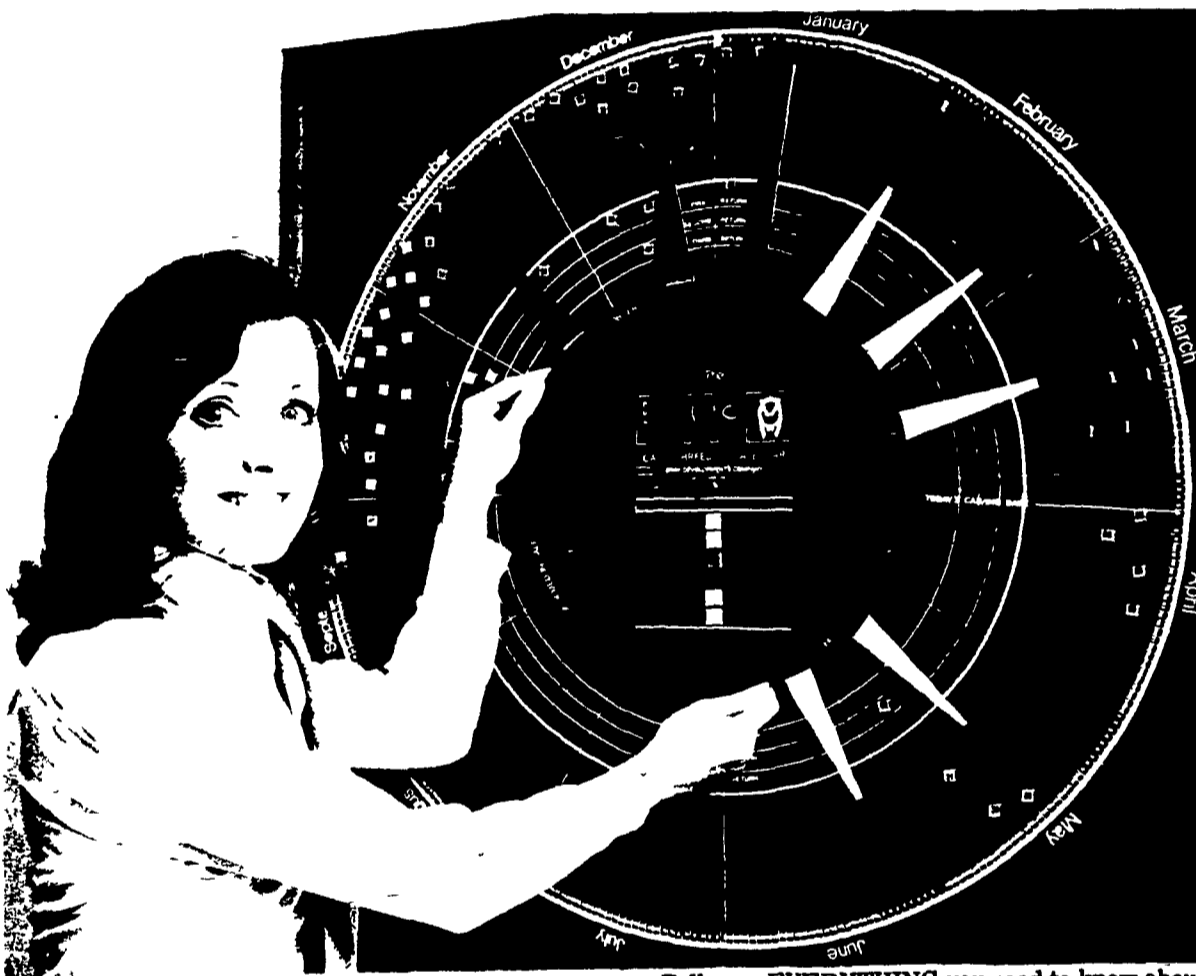

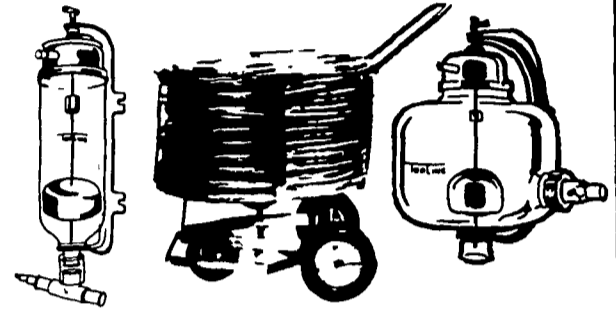
