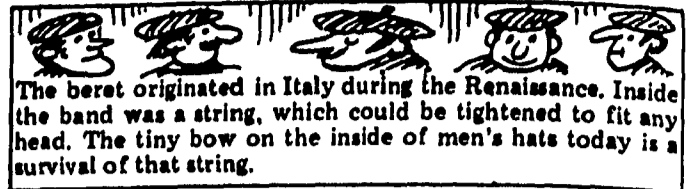

Dear Livestock Farmer;

Dr. Cloy Knodt tells us that a ton of good quality alfalfa haylage containing 40% moisture and 20% crude protein on a dry matter basis can be an excellent source of protein and considerable economic value. Such haylage contains enough crude protein to equal that of 545 lbs. of 44% protein soybean meal which would cost \$54.50 (\$200.00 per ton) or \$65.40 (\$240.00 per ton). Therefore, alfalfa haylage can easily be worth \$50 to \$65 per ton just for its crude protein value as compared to buying soybean meal.

NCEN PR Budget Request Approved

"The American Egg Board approved the first request of the National Commission on Egg Nutrition for \$175,000 to continue its program on cholesterol at a meeting in Chicago on February 28,"

according to Edward Murphy, AEB Chairman. Hendrik Wentink, Chairman of the Commission, outlined the program and presented the request.

Nineteen of the 25 active Directors, including all members of the Executive Committee, were present.

In addition to items for public relations, legal, and medical advisory fees, the budget included items to cover one or more professionally qualified spokesmen for the Commission, scripts, tapes, discs and film for public service radio and television, presenting the egg story.

A Fact Kit for egg industry people to better equip them to answer questions locally, 5 small exhibits for industry use, and a new nutrition column were also included.

"We believe the commitment of the first \$175,000

re-emphasizes that AEB supports the work of the National Commission on Egg Nutrition and the dedication of each of the Commissioners on behalf of the entire egg industry," Murphy concluded.

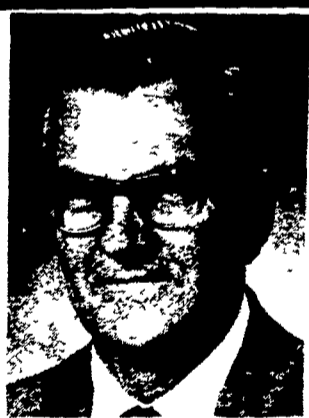

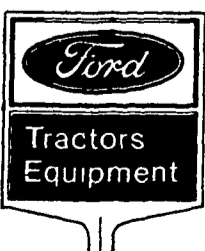
