New Waste Collection System Helps Solve Fuel Crisis

A new fuel-saving, waste collection system has been developed by Orbic Collection Systems, Inc., to help solve the "garbage explosion" problem.

According to William W. Evans, president of OCS, a Washington, D.C. based company, the United States produced a mountainous 250 million tons of refuse in 1972—over five pounds per person daily. And this "garbage explosion" is growing at a rate of eight per cent annually, he noted.

The new system—called Orbic—offers municipalities a means of attacking this problem through an integrated waste collection service utilizing recyclable refuse bags designed to completely eliminate the garbage can and specially made shredder-compactor garbage trucks.

A tremendous advantage of the Orbic System is its fuel saving capabilities. For example the Orbic System could save a city with a population of 25,000 up to 49,920 gallons of gasoline per year. With the average suburban police patrol car averaging eight miles per gallon of gasoline, the fuel savings from Orbic could give the car about 400,000 more miles.

A few of the other advantages offered individual residents as well as the community at large are cleaner streets and quieter garbage pickups. Mr. Evans explained the waste collection service combines the bag, a newly designed truck and chassis, and improved computerized routing techniques.

He described the recyclable paper bag container as a "one-way garbage can." The bags are collected, placed in a hopper, shredded and compacted while the truck moves swiftly through the street. The truck's

specially designed body can also compact sofas, chairs or other old furniture.

When the truck has finished a block, the area is clean without unsightly receptacles to attract flies, rodents or other animals.

For the homeowner the bags are easy to use, Mr. Evans said. Orbic supplies a holding rack for the homeowner to attach the bag to while it is being filled. Then the homeowner simply removes the bag, curls the top and places the new bag on the rack.

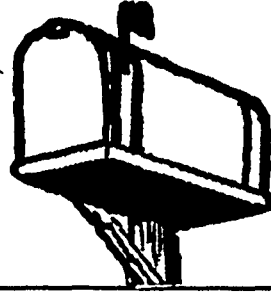
The system reduces environmental problems at disposal sites, a major area of

complaint from residents in many communities.

According to Mr. Evans, ecological improvements will be immediate whether municipalities dispose of sacks as landfill or in incinerators.

Summing up some of the benefits to homeowners and the community Mr. Evans noted the following:

- neater, cleaner streets
- reduction in noise and air pollution
- improved health conditions
- attractive vehicles and containers
- no post-can repairs or cleaning
- lower cost

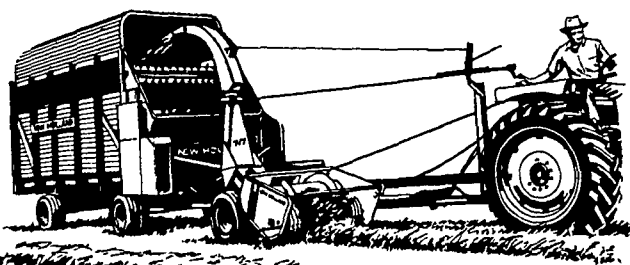

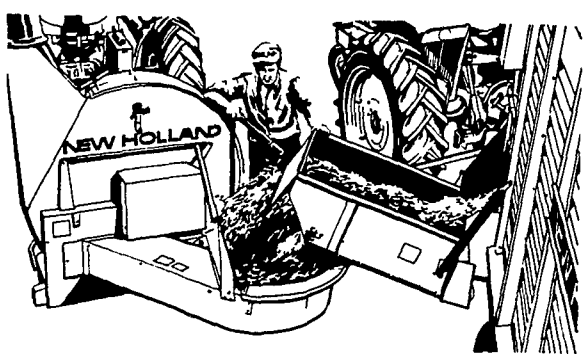
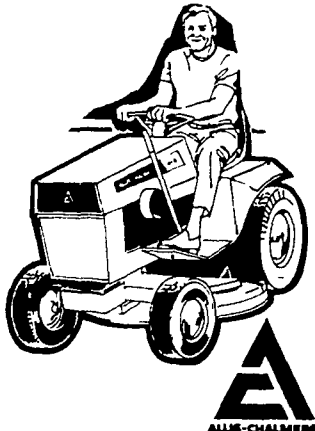
