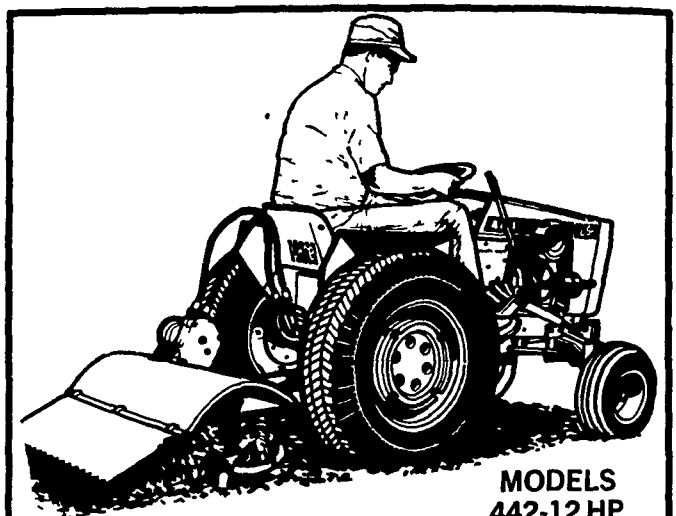

County loan and purchase schedules for 1974-crop barley as issued today by the U.S. Department of Agriculture reflect the national average loan rate of 90 cents per bushel announced Aug. 29, 1973. Changes have been made in county-to-county relation-

ships to reflect increased transportation costs, changes in the marketing pattern and area-to-area price relationships.

The 1974-crop county loan rates are for barley grading No. 2 or better (except Mixed Barley).

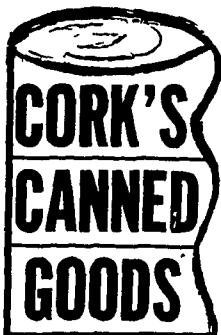
