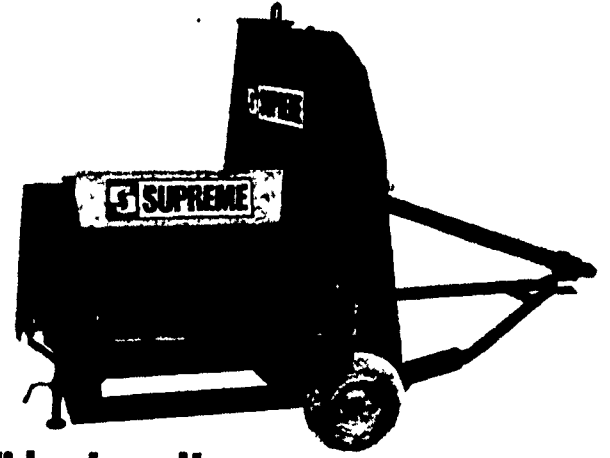
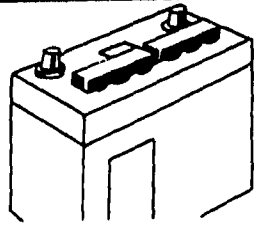
Penn Manor
