Perishability and product quality both bear on the ability of a processing or distribution firm to meet the market requirements for finished food products.

Production schedules for

perishable commodities must be closely coordinated with processing schedules and marketing. One way to do that is to run your own farm. Direct ownership likewise enables better control of product quality than by dealing with large numbers of independent farmers.

For the firms studied, much of the integration involving livestonk commodities was oriented toward inputs, dairy excepted, as opposed to marketing activities. From senior treasurers gave their half to all of the beef cattle and poultry farm firms were integrated into inputs, prinicipally feed manufacturing. 


