# USDA Revises Gypsy Moth Regulations

The list of articles exempted from regulations of the gypsy moth quarantine, was slightly revised by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), effective May 3.

The revised exemption now allows movement of all stone and quarry products without certification if surveys show that the materials have not been exposed to infestation. Previously, non-exposed ground or pulverized stone and quarry items were allowed shipment without being certified.

The action was taken by USDA's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS). According to Joseph T. Koski, Northeastern Regional Director for APHIS Plant Protection and Quarantine Programs in Moorestown, N.J.: "Improved quarry sanitation

conditions and control procedures in recent years have reduced the likelihood

of spreading gypsy moth with these products. Movements of stone and quarry items no longer have high risk in terms of artificially spreading gypsy moths outside the quarantined areas."

The gypsy moth was brought into this country in 1869 for scientific purposes, but accidentally escaped. Eleven northeastern states are now under quarantine

regulations. Gypsy moth caterpillars damage and kill trees by stripping them of their foliage.

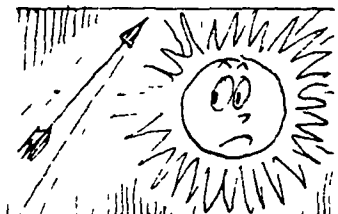

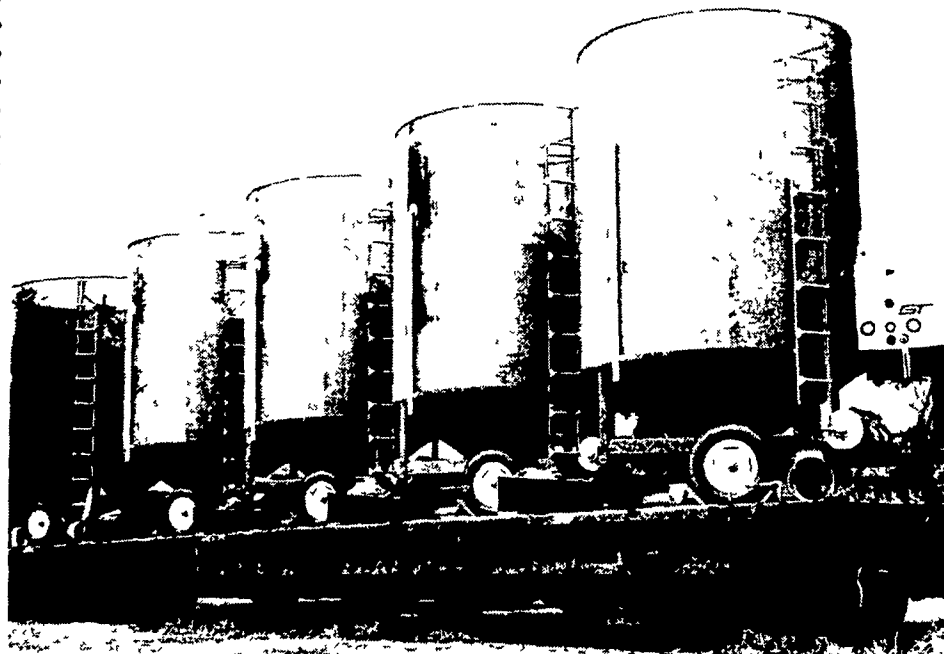
Arrows were shot into the air by South American Indians during an eclipse to frighten the sun into shining again (It always seemed to work too!)

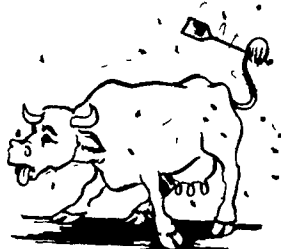
