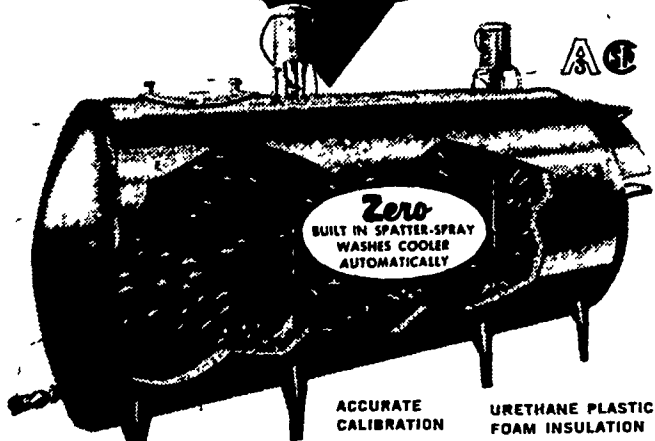

## Sire Power Sale Set for July 30

Plans are well underway for the 1974 Sire Power Sale to be held at the Kutztown Fairgrounds on July 30. The sale which averaged over \$2000 last year will feature daughters of Sire Power sires from all over the Sire Power service area.

Sire Power, Inc. is a federation of three farmer owned and controlled artificial breeding cooperatives serving Maryland, West Virginia, New Jersey and much of Pennsylvania. Northeastern Breeders Association or NEBA, provides the Professional A.I. Technician service for over 155,000 cows in dairy and beef herds in the Pennsylvania and New Jersey area.

Sire Power provides direct herd service for herdsmen inseminators in each of the member co-op areas by bringing breeding supplies,

liquid nitrogen for refrigeration and frozen semen to the farm. A total of over a quarter of a million cows are bred each year through the services of Sire Power and its member cooperatives.

Headquarters for Sire Power and NEBA is located in Tunkhannock, Pa., 717-836-3127.

Presently, about 140 young and proven genetically superior sires in all major dairy and beef breeds are available through Sire Power and NEBA service. Additional semen may be purchased from many other co-op bull studs in the United States as well as Carnation-Genetics and New Breeds Industries. Visitors are welcome at the stud facilities in Tunkhannock from 8 to 5, after which the barns are closed to visitors for reasons of safety.

What Dr. Jekyll wanted to do was to separate the good from the evil, so that, using his medical methods, man could always be good. But all he did was separate himself into two beings—one a saint and the other a devil.

Teacher's Scotch Information Centre can tell you that R.L.S. based his Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde story on a real man. He was Deacon William Brodie, who lived in Edinburgh in the 18th century. By day he was a most respectable man and a member of Edinburgh Town Council. By night he was the leader of a gang of burglars.

In today's terms Deacon Brodie was "Mr. Big." He masterminded the depredations of the gang, and occasionally took part in the robberies himself. Eventually he was caught and, together with some of the gang, was hanged in public in Edinburgh in 1788.

If you visit the Royal Mile, which runs from Edinburgh Castle to the Palace of Holyroodhouse, you'll see an inn called "Deacon Brodie's Tavern." You can enter, order a drink, and muse on the fact that every man is at least two men. And if you believe that, you order another drink for your other self.

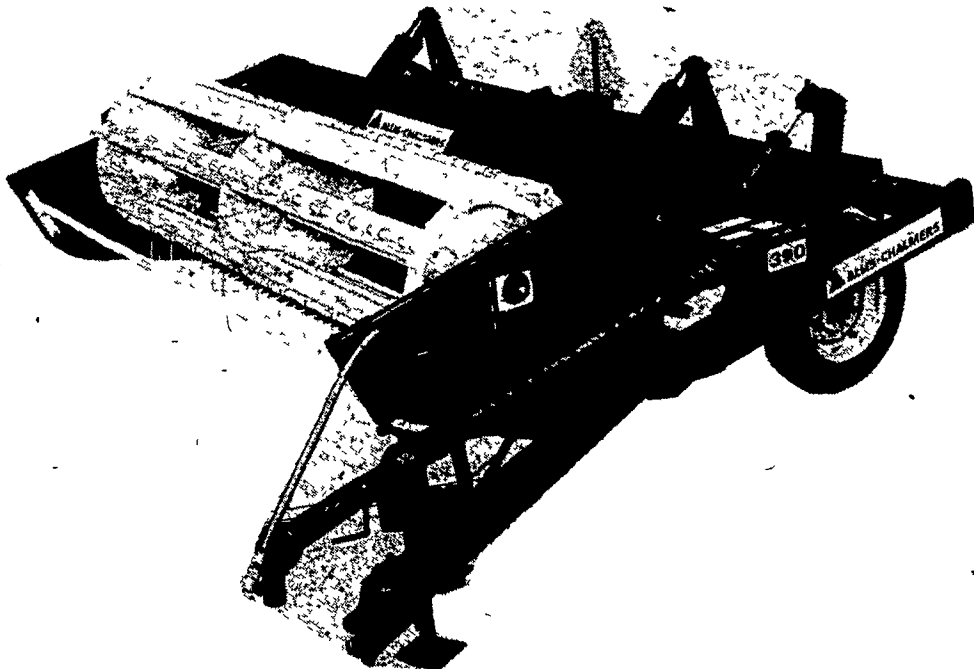
