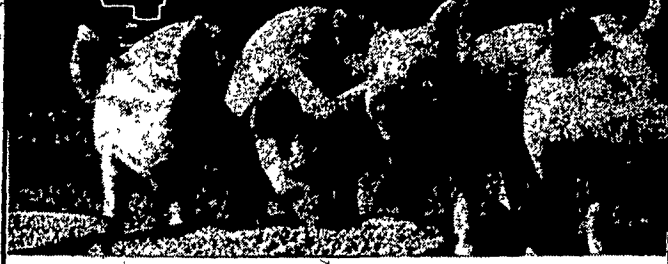

The award winning posters were made by Diane

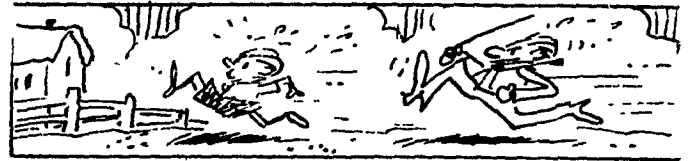
