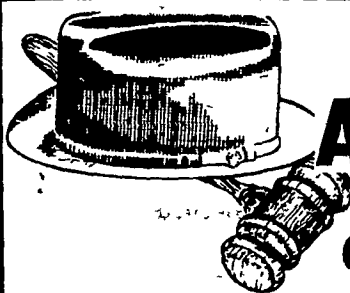

Lawn Mowing

Lawn mowing is at maximum speed this time of the year and here are a few tips to have a good lawn: (1) Mow often so that not more than one-third of the leaf blade is removed at a time; (2) Mow only when the grass is dry; wet grass is harder to cut and may boll up and clog the mower; (3) Remove the grass clippings when growth is heavy and at least 50
