## South Mountain 4-H Club

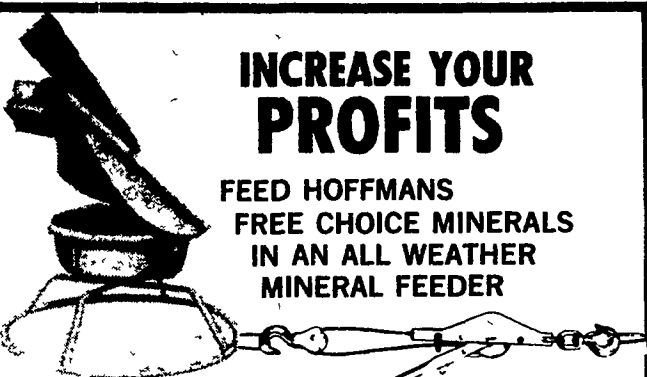
