50 lbs. milk/cow/day at \$7.80 cwt =	\$3.90	50 lbs. milk/cow/day at \$9.20 cwt =	\$4.60
15 lbs. grain/cow/day at \$140/ton =	1.05	15 lbs. grain/cow/day at \$130/ton =	.98
Income over cost of grain/cow/day =	\$2.85	Income over cost of grain/cow/day =	\$3.62

DIFFERENCE; \$.77 Per Cow Per Day.

NOW, RELATE THESE FIGURES TO YOUR OPERATION:

40 cows=\$30.80 more per day, \$ 924 more per month
 50 cows=\$38.50 more per day, \$1,155 more per month
 70 cows=\$53.90 more per day, \$1,617 more per month
 100 cows=\$77.00 more per day, \$2,310 more per month
