Grow Your Own Fruit

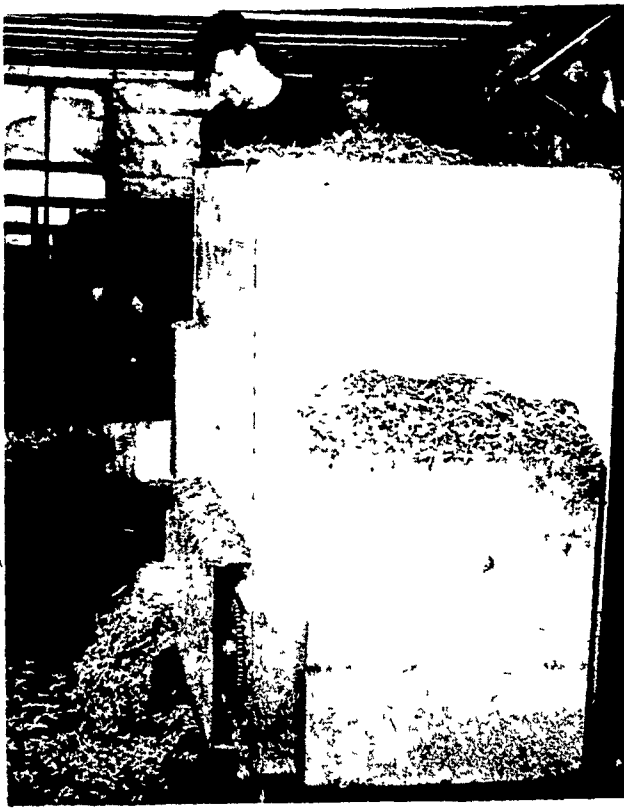
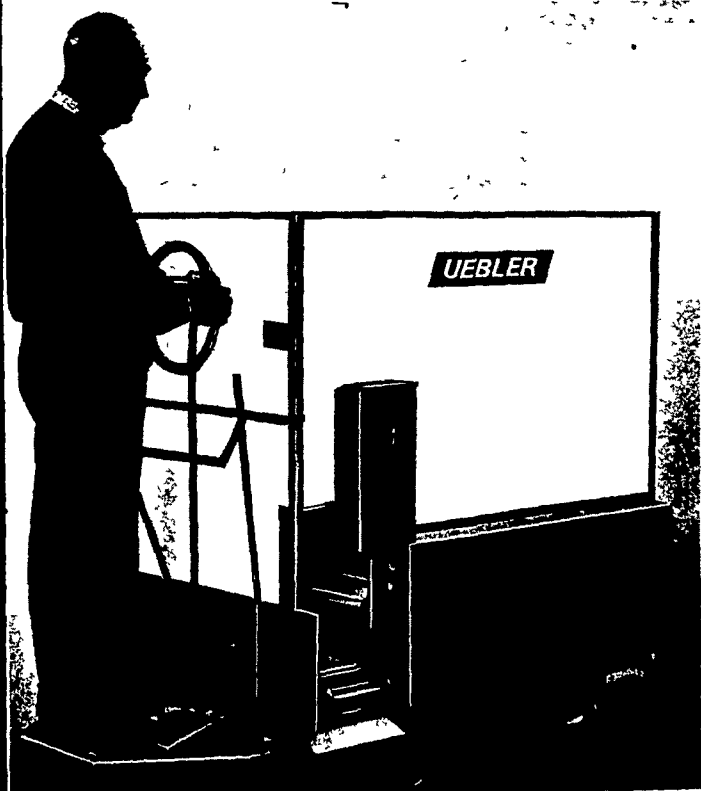
If you have an acre or two of fertile land you're not really using, why not start a small orchard. Most of us enjoy fruit and you can grow it with good care and management.
