Pour batter gradually over beaten egg whites, gently folding with rubber scraper just until blended. DO NOT TIR
Pour into ungreased $10 \times 4$ inch tube pan. Bake 55 minutes at 325 degrees, then increase to 350 degrees for 10 to 15 minutes, until top springs back when lightly touched. Turn pan upside down placing tube over neck of funnel or bottle. let hang untul cold. Loosen with spatula. Ice cake with fluffy white icing. Decorate with small candies or candied fruits if desired.

Bake at 350 degrees for about 35 minutes. Makes two 7 inch layers.

ICING FOR VELVET CAKE
Make paste of 5 tablespoons flour and 1 cup milk, mixing carefully to eliminate all lumps. Boil, over low mixing stirring constantly, till thick. Cool, then beat 1 cup granulated sugar, 1 cup butter and 1 teaspoon vanilla. Mix with milk paste and stir until desired consistency and spread on cake. Makes a soft fluffy icing.

CHOCOLATE BROWNIES
Melt in double boiler:
2 squares semi-sweet chocolat
1-3 cup shortening
Add:
1 cup sugar
2 eggs
