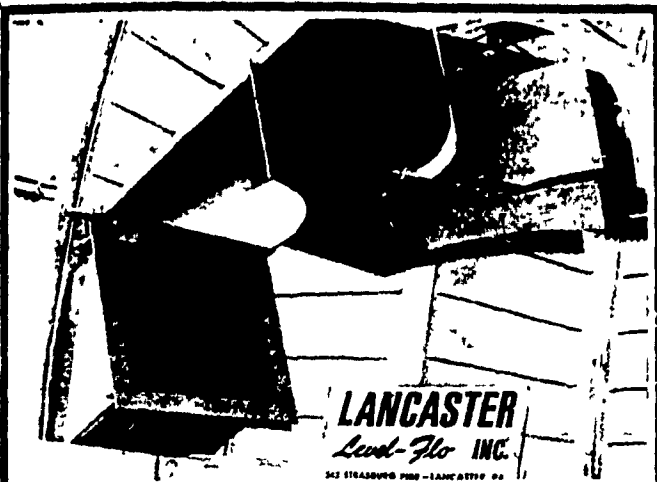
## Growing Degree Days

For week ending September 2

In Lancaster the average temperature for the week was 78 degrees or 8 degrees over the average.

Growing degree days for crops starting at 40 degrees totaled 4071 or 97 over the average. For crops beginning at 50 degrees the days totaled 2577 or 73 days over the average.

Rainfall for the week was 1.15 inches and measured from April 1:22.06 inches or .55 inches over the normal.

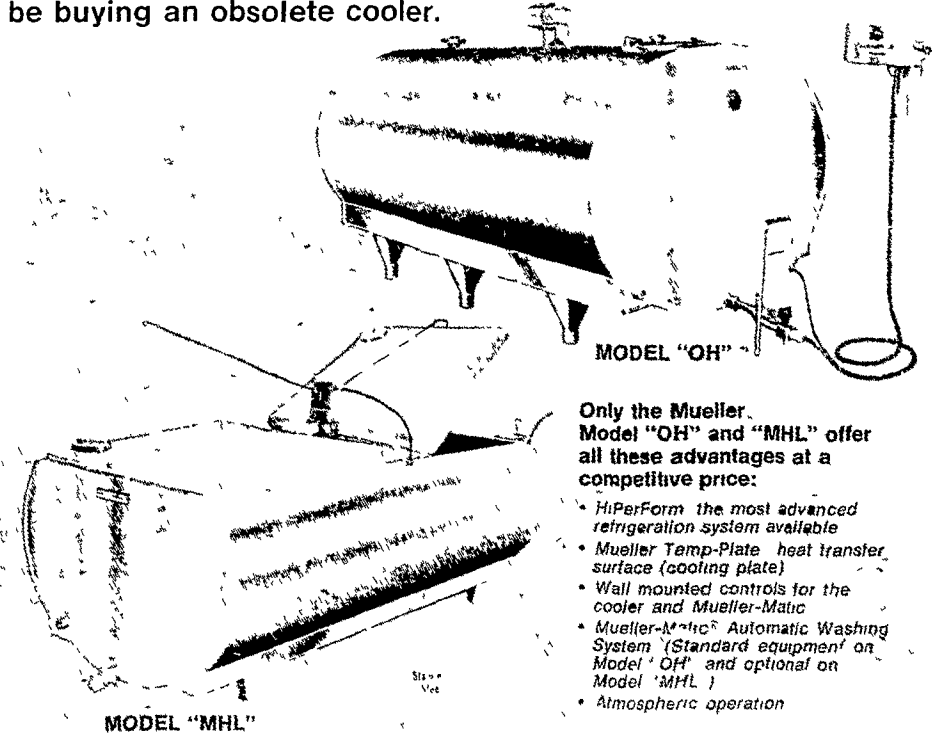
