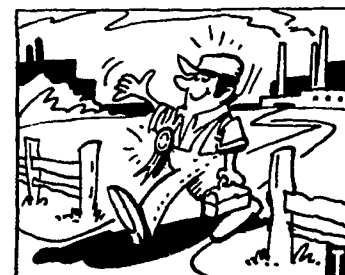

### Industrial Company Wins Tops Safety Award

Every year the National Safety Council awards its own "Oscar." For an outstanding performance by an industrial company in the field of employee safety.

This year Union Carbide Corporation won it.

Called the Award of Honor, it is the Council's highest award for an excellent safety record. The winning record for work done in 1973 featured a rate for disabling injuries of only 1.47 million employee-hours worked.



The award was based on the safety performance of all 73,754 Union Carbide employees in the United States, Canada and Puerto Rico.

National Safety Council estimates that fewer than 5 out of every 1,000 work units in the United States can qualify for this coveted award. Two dozen long-service employees (one with a 42-year service record) traveled to New York to receive it.
