Cream the shortening and sugar. Beat the eggs well and add with molasses and sour cream. Sift dry ingredients and add gradually.

Chill the dough. Drop by spoonful on a greased baking pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 10 minutes.

Chicken and Mushroom Delight

Rinse, pat dry and slice 1 pound fresh mushrooms (makes about 5 cups) or drain 2 cans (6 to 8 oz each) sliced mushrooms in a large skillet heat 2 tablespoons of butter or margarine Add the mushrooms and saute 5 minutes Add 2 cups diced, cooked chicken, cook until heated, set aside Dissolve 3 chicken bouillon cubes in 2 cups boiling water. stir in one cup heavy cream, set aside In a large saucepan heat 3 tablespoons butter or margarine Stir in 3 tablespoons flour blend well Gradually mix in bouillon and cream mixture Cook and stir over low heat until slightly thickened Stir in ¾ cup grated Romano or Parmesan cheese and 1/16 teaspoon ground white pepper Add reserved mushrooms and chicken, heat only until hot Serve over spaghetti Yields 6 portions
