

Donors Help "Make 4-H Happen"

"We Can Make It Happen". That's the theme of 1974 National 4-H Week, October 6-12. And observing the occasion are nearly 5.3 million 4-H boys and girls, some 560,000 volunteer adult leaders, plus countless others who support 4-H programs in all 50 states, Puerto Rico and the District of Columbia.

Helping them observe 1974 National 4-H Week are nearly 60 businesses, corporations and foundations that support the Cooperative Extension Service administered 4-H program through the National 4-H Service Committee.

In 1974, the National Committee has budgeted nearly \$3½ million dollars to aid the national 4-H program. These funds provide, educational aids and literature, incentives and recognition, leader training and numerous other services.

In the area of incentives and recognition, corporate friends of 4-H help 4-H'ers "make it happen" by providing 265 educational scholarships valued at \$184,100. Many of these grants will be awarded during the 53rd National 4-H Congress in Chicago, Dec. 1-5. A high percentage of the 1,600 teens scheduled to participate in five days of seminars, tours, events and entertainment earn expense-paid trips given by friends of 4-H.

By bringing together young people of different racial, economic and social backgrounds in various pro-

grams and activities, 4-H provides youth with the opportunity to interact and to help "make it happen". Interaction and communication between young people and adults are fostered through 4-H participation. Such dialog and cooperation contributes measurably to the molding and shaping of youthful lives and preparing them for adult life.

Many 4-H programs are particularly relevant in terms of concerns expressed by today's youths and adults alike. Among them bicycle safety is a fast growing and popular program among 4-H'ers. In the 4-H bicycle program, sponsored by The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, youths learn how to safely operate and maintain their bikes and assume leadership roles with younger children.

With increasing emphasis being placed on agricultural production, numerous 4-H projects contribute directly to much needed food supplies. Assisting in the sheep program is Wilson & Co., Inc., Kentucky Fried Chicken supports the poultry program and The Chicago Board of

Trade, work in commodity marketing.

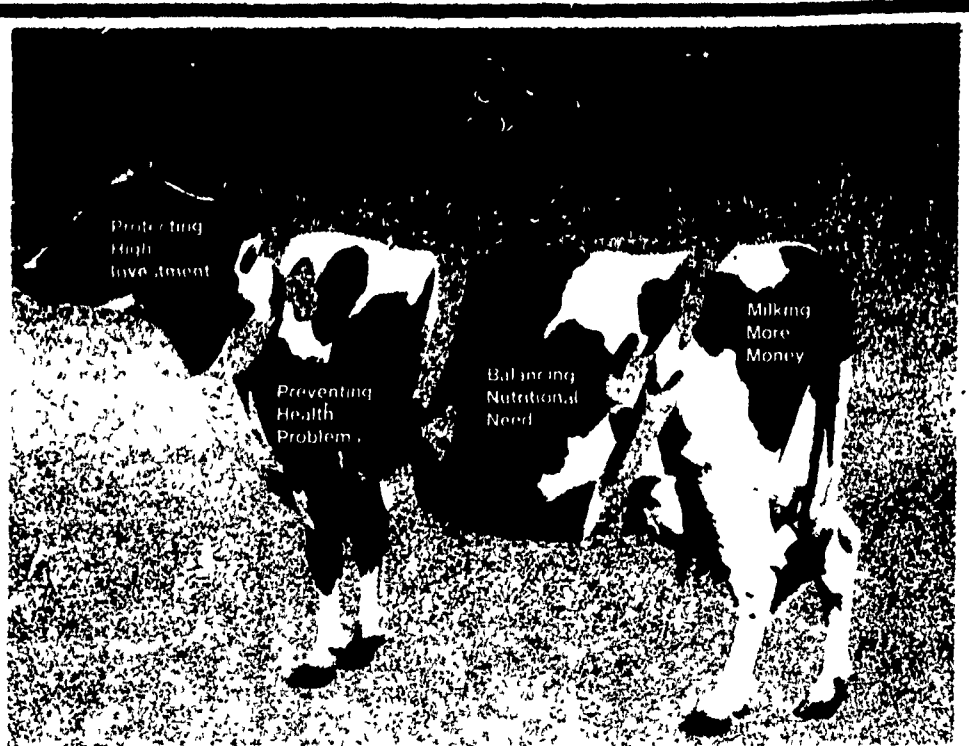

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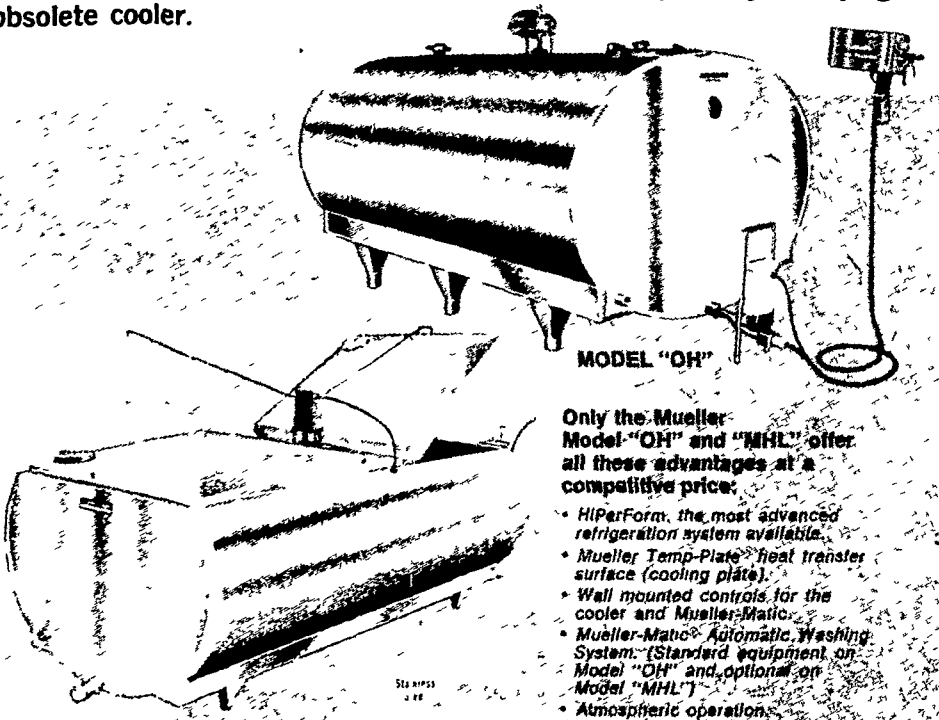
