


York County DHIA MONTHLY REPORT



SEPTEMBER 1974

Over 1,000 pounds of fat was the highest lactation completed this month. A 6 year old Registered Holstein cow, B Star, owned by Avalong Farms Inc. RD6, York completed a 305 day record of 21,029 at a 4.8 percent test for a total of 1,012 pounds of fat. Second high lactation was completed by Jewel, a 4 year old Registered Holstein owned by Sinking Spring Farms Inc., RD6, York. In 305 days Jewel produced 23,186 pounds of milk at a 4.0 test for 931 pounds of fat.

The herd of David Stewart, RD2, Delta, had the highest daily butterfat average. The herd of 54 registered Holstein cows averaged 53 pounds of milk, and 2.08 pounds of fat at a 3.9 percent test. Sinking Springs Farm was second high with 54.1 pounds of milk and 2.02 pounds of butterfat daily with a 3.7 percent test on 64 cows.


