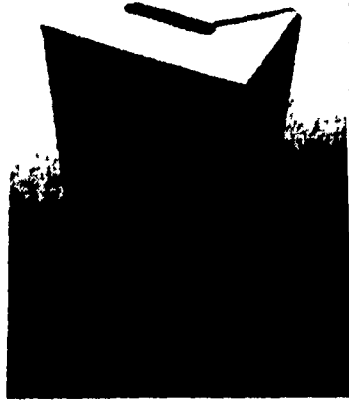




A Charolais Show and sale was held on Oct. 18th at the Vintage Sale Stables. Daniel Good, Columbia took first place for his pen of cattle.



This little orange-and-black UNICEF box will be a familiar sight on Halloween when millions of youngsters ring America's doorbells to request help for needy children in the developing

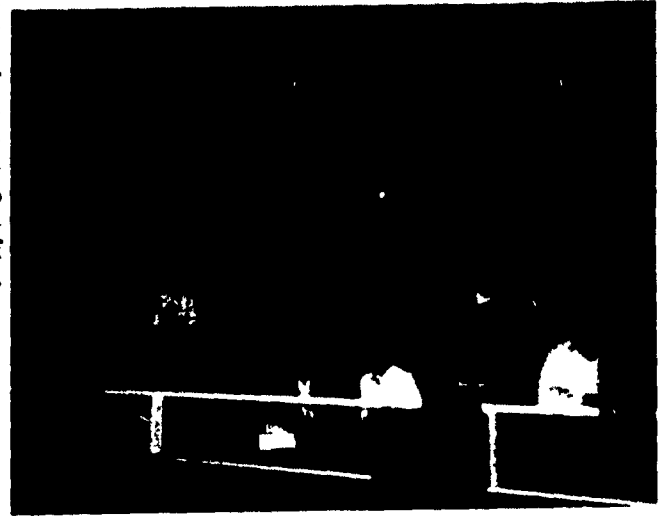

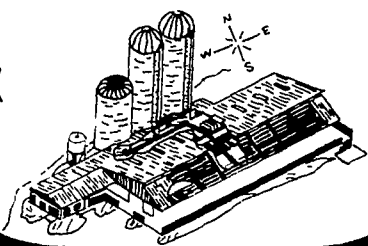
