

Snyder Elected Grange Master

J. Luther Snyder, of Camp Hill (Cumberland County) was installed recently as the 16th master of the Pennsylvania State Grange.

Snyder was elected to a two-year term to succeed A. Wayne Readinger, of Fleetwood RD1, (Berks County) who rounded out six years of service as master of the State Grange.

The new master had served as state Grange secretary since 1966 and was the twelfth man to fill that position. He also had served as state deputy master for York and Adams counties, master of the York-Adams Pomona Grange and of Valley Grange No. 1360, of Lewisberry. Prior to 1966, Snyder had been with the U.S. Postal Service and before that was engaged in production control with the U.S. Air Force at Middletown.

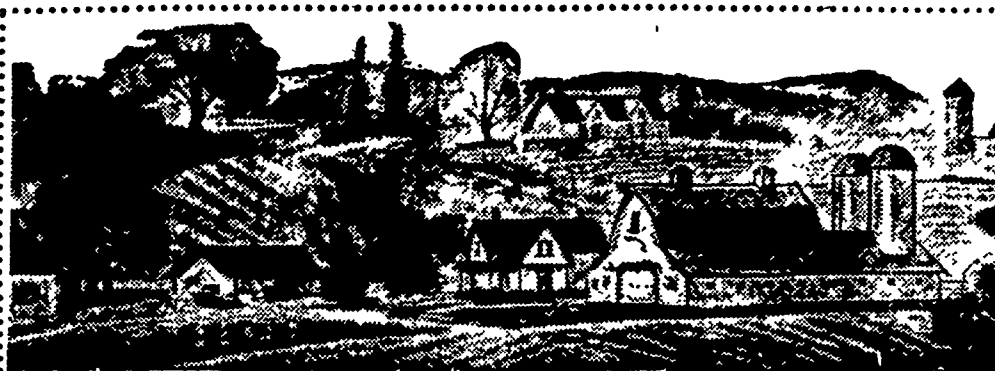

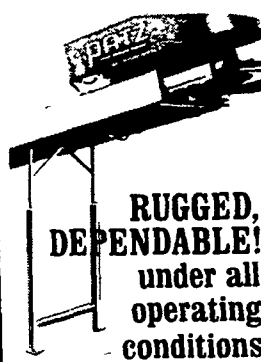
