or destroy disease producing bacteria. But the only weapon we have against bacteria or other organisms that can invade and destroy the udder or even the cow is the resistance of the cow herself.

Dairymen often fail to recognize that many stress factors affect the cow's ability to resist infection. Greatest of these is an injury to the teat end. Good milking and good sanitation have a tremendous effect on the health of udders. Dairymen who know that their cows have mastitis or are producing abnormal milk should take a serious look at the management of their cows before they resort to the use of antibiotics.

You and your veterinarian must recognize that labels on all medicines safe to give to milk producing animals clearly state proper doses and withholding times.

No dairyman or veterinarian would contribute to antibiotic residues in milk or meat if label directions were followed. Don't lose two days worth of milk or a butcher cow - follow the instructions on the label.

Treat Plastic Tubing In Dairy Carefully
Plastic tubing is widely used in the dairy industry. Both clear and flexible types are used for transferring milk from cows to bulk tank and later to tank trucks. Properly handled it is tough and will last for five or more years.

Proper cleaning, sanitizing and drying procedures are essential. You should follow manufacturers directions very closely.

Removal of the plasticizing material causes lack of flexibility and etching. High temperatures

(over 160 degrees F), strong alkaline cleaners and inadequate rinsing cause this condition. The result is an inner surface which is hard and brittle. During use plastic tubing must be flexible. Temperature variations cause expansion and contractions. This leaves the surface full of scaly areas. They may trap milk and cause quality problems.
