or destroy disease producing becteria. But the only weapon we have against bacteria or other organisms that can invade and destroy the udder or even the cow is the resistance of the cow herself.

Dairymen often fail to recognize that many stress factors affect the cow's ability to resist infection. Greatest of these is an injury to the teat end. Good milking and good sanitation have a tremendous effect on the health of udders. Dairymen who know that their cows have mastitis or are producing abnormal milk should take a serious look at the management of their cows before they resort to the use of antibiotics

You and your veterinarian must recognize that lables on all medicines safe to give to milk producing animals clearly state proper doses and withholding times.

or dairyman veterinarian would contribute to antibiotic residues in milk or meat if lable directions were followed. Don't lose two days worth of milk or a butcher cow follow the instructions on the label.

#### Treat Plastic Tubing In Dairy Carefully

Plastic tubing is widely used in the dairy industry. Both clear and flexible types are used for transferring milk from cows to bulk tank and later to tank trucks. Properly handled it is tough and will last for five or more




