

LEBANON COUNTY DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

OCTOBER 1974

A cow in the herd of Hershey Bare recorded the highest lactation record with 945 pounds of butterfat, 23,614 pounds of milk and a 4.0 percent test. Second high in lactation was Lily in the herd of Harold Bollinger. The cow produced 906 pounds of butterfat with 24,005 pounds of milk and a 3.8 percent test.

High in the herd summary was the herd of Harold Bollinger recording 1.76 pounds of fat with David Brandt recording second high production with 1.71 pounds per day.

The Lebanon County Dairy Herd Improvement Association records of tests of county cows with over 600 pounds of fat in October are as follows:
