



BERKS COUNTY DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

OCTOBER 1974

Two cows in the Muddy Creek Farm herd recorded the top butterfat production for the month of October. Julia produced 927 pounds of butterfat with 22,714 pounds of milk. Sandy produced 911 pounds of butterfat with 23,749 pounds of milk.

John H. Stump's herd of 51 cows recorded the highest average per cow with 1.88. Second high was the 40 cow herd of Kenneth L. Stutzman with 1.75. Harold G. Heck's herd also recorded 1.75.
