4 teaspoon nutmeg


1 cup chopped nuts

4½ lbs. sugar

2 qts. white vinegar 1 tablespoon whole cloves

1 teaspoon celery seed 1 tablespoon salt

1 tablespoon mixed pickling spice

(Spices may be tied in a net bag). Bring above mixture to a boil, then cool and add to cucumbers. Let stand over night. Next day boil cucumbers in syrup for 35 minutes and can in sterilized jars. Makes approximately 7 pints. DO NOT USE ALUMINUM UTENSILS BECAUSE OF THE LIME.
