

House Honors Darwin Boyd

Darvin E. Boyd, has been honored by the Pennsylvania House of Representatives for his work over the past two years as executive director of the House Committee on Health and Welfare.

Boyd is the son of Elmer Boyd, Ephrata R1, and a former 4-H'er and participated in the International Farm Youth Exchange program. From 1966 to 1972, he was 4-H program director for the American-Korean Foundation in Seoul, Korea. He is a graduate of Delaware

Valley College, where he earned a BS in animal husbandry, and holds a masters of public administration from Penn State.

This marks the second time Boyd has been cited by the Pennsylvania House. In 1972, he was cited for receiving the National Medal-Order of Civil Merit from the Korean government. The present citation was sponsored by Kenneth B. Lee, speaker of the House, and representatives George

W. Gekas, Kent Shelhamer and Sherman L. Hill.

In a speech accompanying the citation, Mr. Lee said, "Darvin Boyd has made valuable contributions to the General Assembly and the Commonwealth by his efforts in procuring the assistance of the United States Commissioner of Welfare in reviewing the statutes, regulations, and procedures of Pennsylvania's Public Assistance Program; in researching, developing and assisting the passage of welfare reform legislation and in informing the House of important issues and matters involving the Commonwealth's Public Assistance Program. He has significantly contributed to the improvement of health and welfare matters in the Commonwealth."

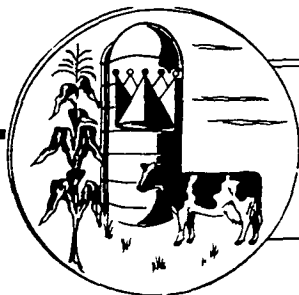

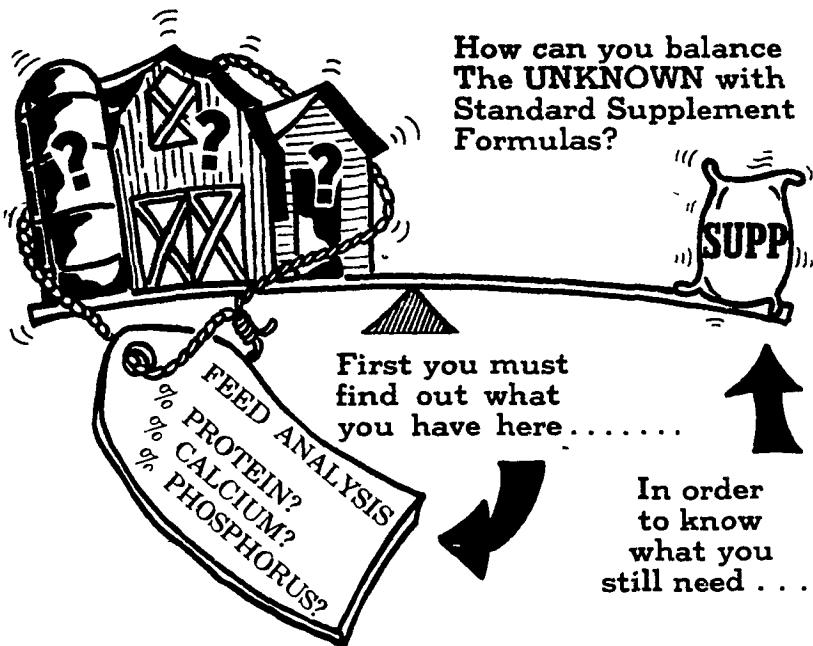
