second and Alfred won the filler while Arthur placed third. The second place filler was shown by Jere Swarr, Manheim R2.

Prior to the tobacco show, the Lancaster County FFA Corn Roundup was held at the Farm and Home Center.

Barry Kreider, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Kreider, Kinzer R1, won the contest with his Dekalb corn which also won him the champion ribbon at the West Lampeter Community Fair.

The contest was judged by John Yocum, superintendent of the Southeast Pennsylvania Field Research Laboratory, near Landisville.

Placing second was Kerry Boyd, Ephrata R1, who also won the 4-H contest last week.

Third place was taken by Galen Long, Columbia R2, while Chuck Groff, Quarryville R3, had the fourth place entries. Doug Riexinger, Lancaster, showed the fifth place corn.

A total of 13 entries from four area high schools competed for ribbons and premiums. The corn will also be exhibited at the State Farm Show.


