4-H Pig Roundup And Sale
Jay Bomgardner, RD3, Annville captured honors on Saturday during the 4-H Pig Roundup and Sale held at the Lebanon Area Fairgrounds. His 215 pound Hampshire market hog was named - Grand Champion of the show and was later bought for \$1.10 a pound by Host acres Quality Meats of RD1, Lebanon. Tom Arnold of Lebanon showed the Reserve Grand Champion, a 230

pound Yorkshire, bought by Hatfield Packing for 85 cents a pound. Both hogs were in the heavyweight class.

Bonnie Arnold, Lebanon, with her two Yorkshire pigs were selected as Lebanon County's entry to the Farm Show.

Jay Bomgardner also was named Champion Fitter of the show while Tom Seaman of Grantville was Champion Showman.

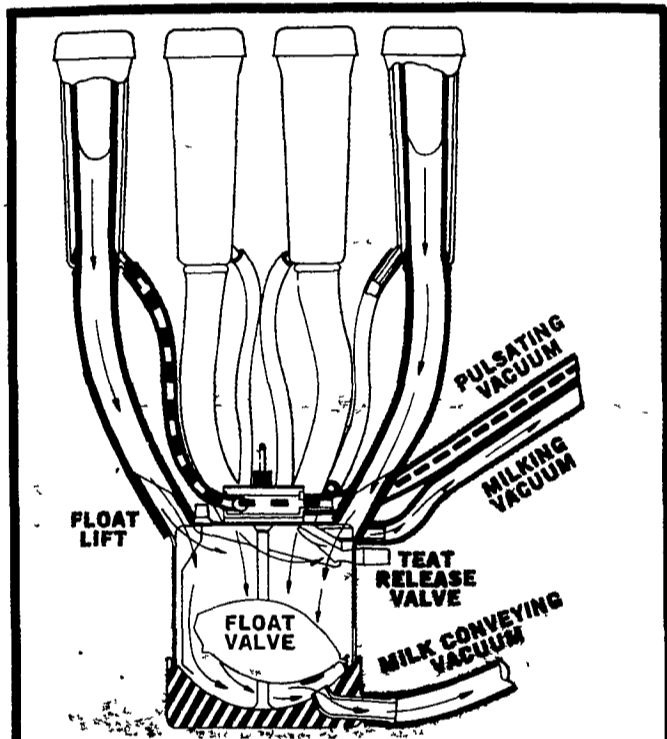

ATTENTION DAIRYMEN:

Did someone say you should put in a 2 inch or 3 inch milk line? Yes, because the conventional pipe lines carry milk, and the milking vacuum in same pipe. Your galvanized pipe only carried pulsation vacuum (the vacuum between shell and inflation.)

Oh, a larger milker line may help your milker, but if a slug of milk goes down a 2" line your vacuum drops, just like in a 1 1/2" line, so before you scrap that old 1 1/2" line, why not use that old 1 1/2" line to transfer milk only, and install another 1 1/2" stainless steel line to carry your milking vacuum, with no milk or liquid in this line you have free moving air, no drop in vacuum. Then use the new Zero pipeline unit with above, you have the best milker you can buy, no air injection needed, to slug milk up the hose.

Did you ever stop and think? Would you like that same air sucked through your drinking water.
