Red Lion Senior High School of York County received fourth place honors and an award of \$50 for their exhibit on "Ways to Stretch Your Food Dollar Value." The display included suggestions on buying, pricing and storing food.

University of Pennsylvania.

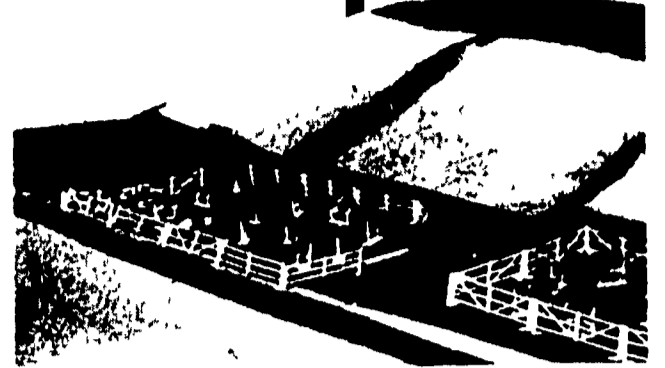

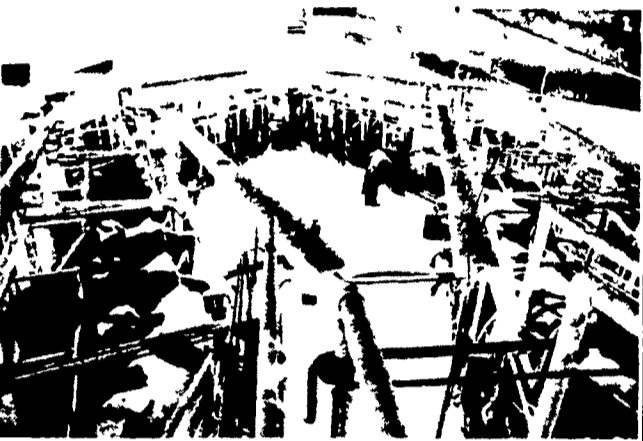

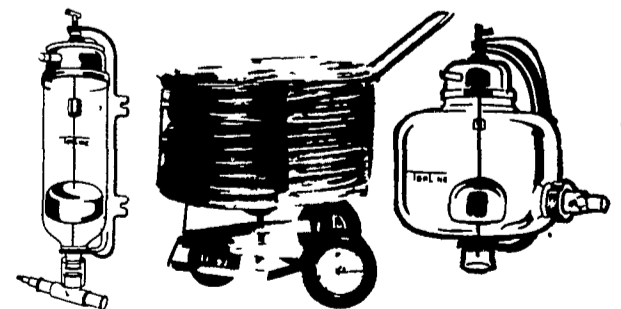
