'74 Hay Champ On Top

Jay McCarrell, of Eighty Four, Washington County, for the second straight year, exhibited the grand

champion sample in hay classes at the 59th Farm Show. The winning entry, a heat dried first cutting of alfalfa sample, contained 22.58 crude protein and 65.9 percent estimated total digestible nutrients.

The reserve champion sample, an air dried later cutting of alfalfa, was exhibited by Albert L. Hack, of RD2, Berwick, Columbia County. The reserve champion sample contained 23.11 percent crude protein and 62.3 percent estimated total digestible nutrients.

Next meeting will be Feb 5 at the 4-H center, preceded by an officer training meeting. All York County officers are invited.

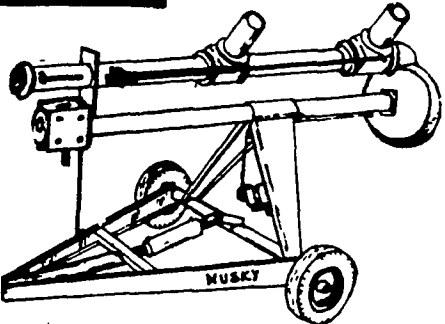

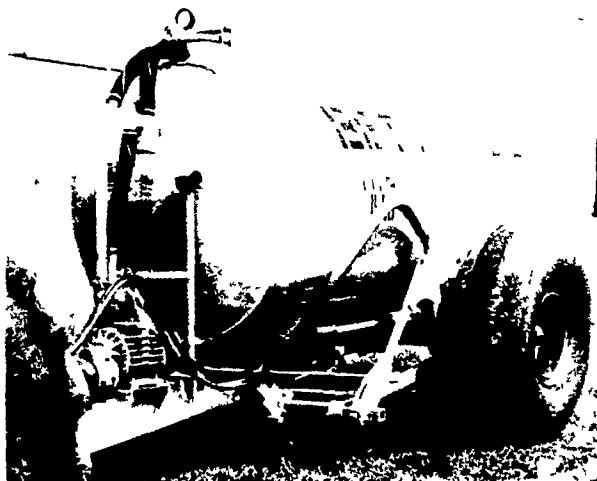

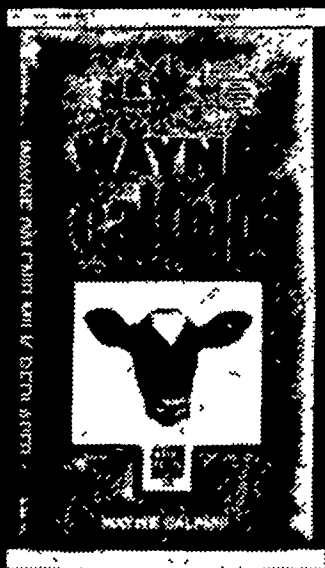
LIQUID MANURE SPREADER

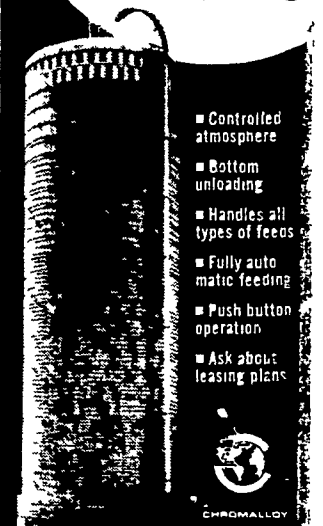
