With new federal labeling thiamine, riboflavin, niacin. calcium, and iron are listed according to their per-centage of the U.S. Recommended Dairy Allowance. By using the U.S. RDA as a guideline for good diet, you can choose foods that are good sources of nutrition.

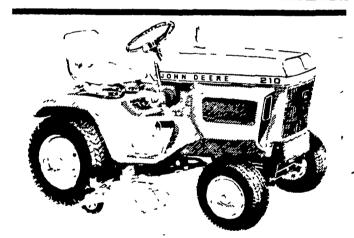
The nutrients are always listed in the same order. Miss Hamilton says this makes it easier to compare different brands and foods in the same food groups. You could compare nutritive values in an ounce of cheese, a cup of milk and a serving of yogurt-all in the milk group.

Some new labels will help you follow special diets. Calories may be listed along with information for persons modifying their cholesterol, fat or sodium intake on the advice of a physican.

Learning to use the added information on food labels can help you make nutritious and economical buys, points out the Extension specialist.
