Chocolate Souffle

 3/4 cup granulated sugar
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 1 teaspoon vanilla
 2 cups heavy cream

Melt chocolate over hot water; soak gelatine in cold water. Stir in 10X sugar in chocolate as well as possible. Heat milk until film shines over surface then stir into chocolate. Cook stirring constantly until boiling point. Remove from heat. Pour into gel, sugar, salt, vanilla; chill until thick as raw egg. Then beat and add whipped cream. Chill in freezer.
