Compared with the previous week's close: Slaughter Steers and Heifers \$ .75-1.00 lower than late previous week, some late sales 1.25-1.50 off in limited trading with Good and Low-Choice 800-850 lb. Heifers in particularly narrow demand. Cows 1.50-2.50 higher. Bulls weak to 1.00 lower.

Four Day Receipts 19,300 as compared 21,900 pervious week and 23,300 a year ago. Slaughter Steers approximately 44 pct. week's total, Heifers 25 pct., cows 15 pct., and Feeders for Friday auction 12 pct.

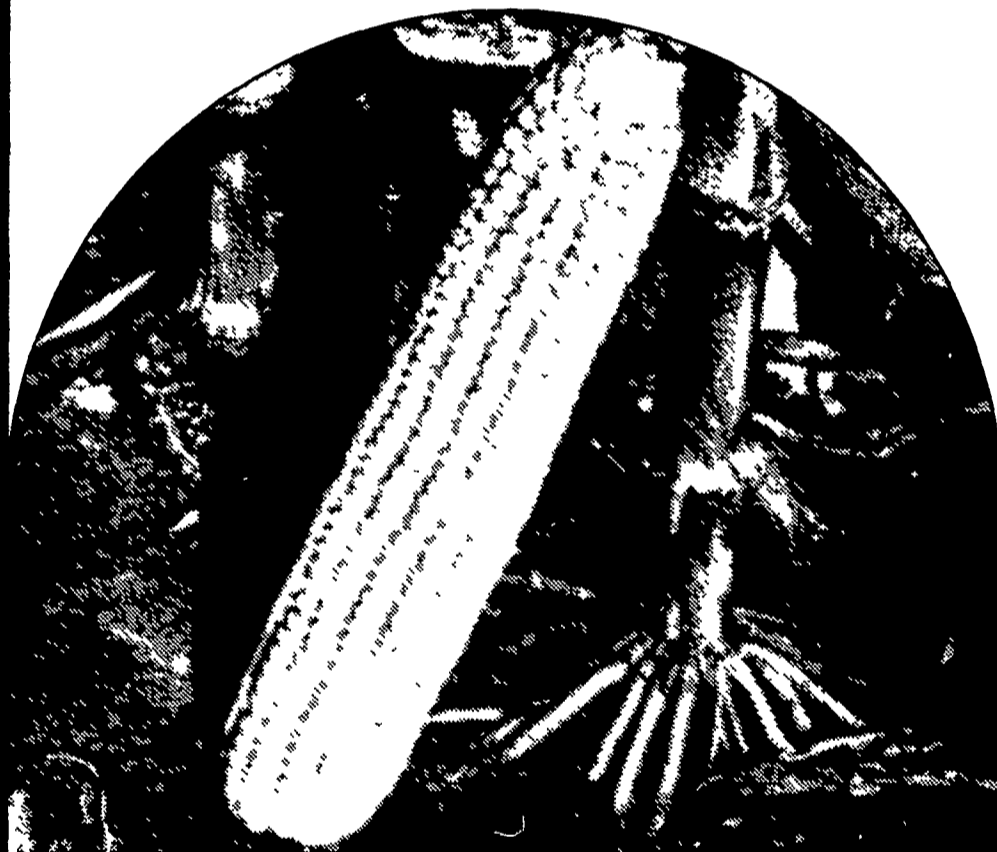
