Tentative Opening Dates Set For '75
Tentative opening dates for 1975 hunting seasons have been established by the Pennsylvania Game Commission for the convenience of those who wish to plan ahead.
The archery deer season this year is tentatively scheduled to open on Saturday, September 27.
The tentative opening date for 1975's early small game

season is Saturday, October 11, while the general small game season is tentatively scheduled to open on Saturday, October 25.
Tentatively, the bear season is scheduled to open on Monday, November 24.
The antlered deer season opening date was previously established by commission action as the Monday following Thanksgiving, which will be on December 1 in 1975.
