F&M Offers 'Et Cetera' Continuing Ed Courses

Franklin and Marshall College is offering 22 non-credit courses this spring in its new "Et Cetera" continuing education program. The courses are grouped into five categories, including current concerns, leisure, personal advancement, law for the layman, and language for beginners.

Topics range from "communicating with children," "fighting inflation," and "writing a family history" to "Lancaster County architecture" and "consumer law."

Stephanie Tolan, coordinator of the program, said today most of the courses will begin the week of February 18, and will meet once a week for five weeks. Tuition ranges from \$15 to \$40, depending on the course.

Individuals interested in the program can call or visit F&M's office of special programs Monday through Thursday from 2 to 7 p.m. or on Friday from 2 to 5 p.m. to obtain the "Et Cetera" brochure or to register for courses.

The telephone number for the office, located in Hartman Hall, is 393-2621 during day hours and 299-0068 in the evening.

In addition to the courses scheduled to start in February, five others are in the planning stage, to start in

either March or April, according to Ms. Tolan.

These include "survival gardening," "creative writing," "technical writing," "early American crafts," and "fund raising." The course in fund raising is being geared to the needs of local non-profit groups.

- Personal advancement-- "Let's Talk", (public address), Feb. 18; "Literary Symbols," Feb. 20; "Reading and Study Skills," Feb. 19; "Speedreading," Feb. 19.
- Law for the layman-- "Consumer Law," Feb. 18; "Real Estate Law," Feb. 19; "Family Law," Feb. 18.

Christmas Seals Stuck For \$

The Lancaster County Lung Association reports that the Christmas Seal Campaign receipts now total \$71,027. This is still \$14,973 short of the \$86,000 needed to conduct services for the next fiscal year starting April 1, 1975.

In an effort to make up the deficit contributors will be asked to make an additional contribution. Contributions are especially needed to finance the newly established Pulmonary Function Screening program which has been offered monthly since April 1974. The purpose of the screening is to detect early signs of breathing impairment so that it can be treated and disabling lung disease prevented.

Christmas Seal contributions support other services such as supervision for Emphysema patients using mechanical equipment at home, loan of breathing machines, as well as tuberculin testing, chest x-ray and information on hazards of smoking and air pollution.

Eighty percent of all contributions will be used for services in Lancaster County. Only 20 percent is allocated for the administration of State and National programs such as research and education.

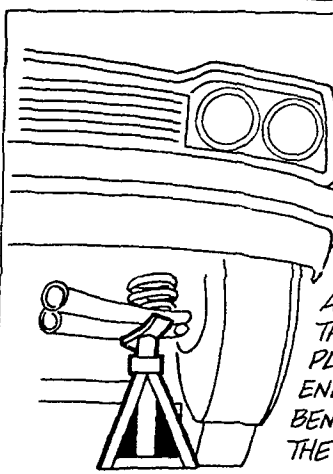

JACK-STANDS
NEVER WORK UNDER A CAR UNLESS IT IS ON JACK STANDS OR WHEEL RAMPS — CHOCK REAR WHEELS — JACK UP ONE SIDE UNTIL THE LOWER SUSPENSION ARM IS LIFTED HIGHER THAN THE TOP OF JACK STAND. PLACE STAND UNDER OUTSIDE END OF THE ARM, DIRECTLY BENEATH COIL SPRING. LOWER THE CAR ONTO STAND.
