Along with their work, the organization has participated in field trips and have sponsored picnics and athletic events.

Many of the members are currently involved in building green houses at the school site and landscaping the area around the vo-tech facility.

Being vo-tech students, many of the young people are on co-op work programs which enables them to work either during the morning or afternoon at establishments in their field of study.

Currently 5 members of the chapter hold their Red Rose FFA degree. Vo-tech students in FFA have somewhat of a difficulty obtaining the county degree however, since their program is actually for only two years. Therefore in their second year they must obtain their chapter degree as well as their county degree.

Hans Herr FFA is the 12th group to be issued a charter in Lancaster County, with the name coming from one of the first prominent settlers of the Lancaster area.

The Chapter is the second to be organized by James Kerr, as he also sparked the initiation of an FFA group at the Brownstown Vo-tech school where he also teaches horticulture.

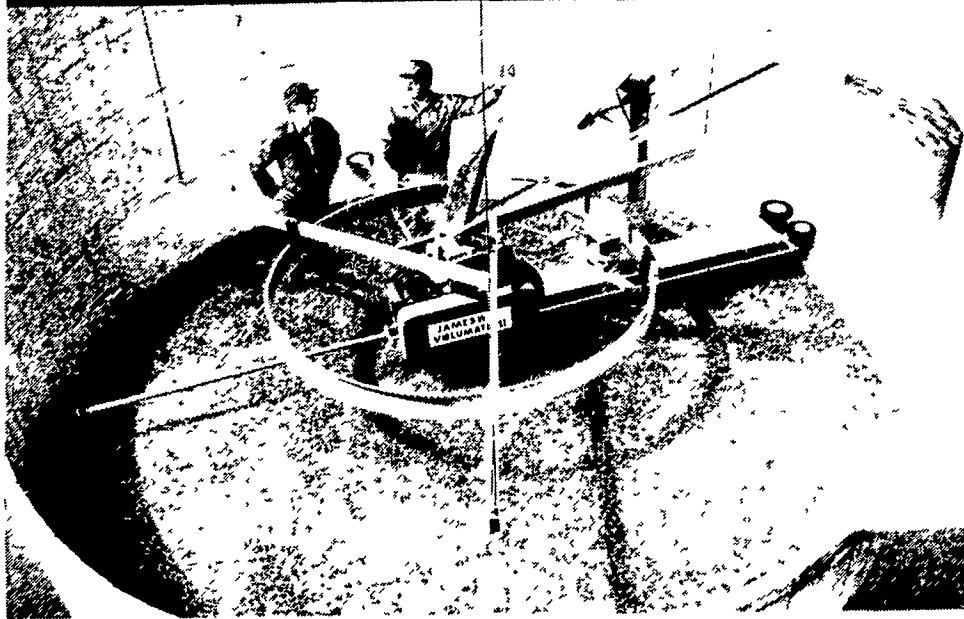

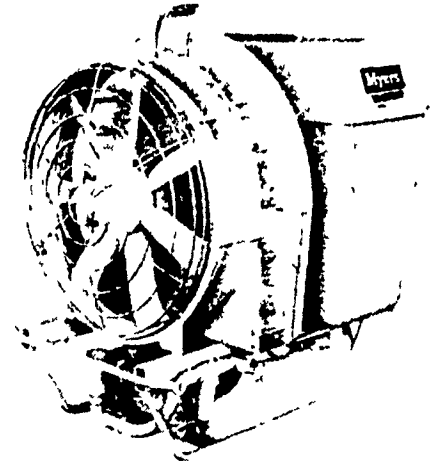

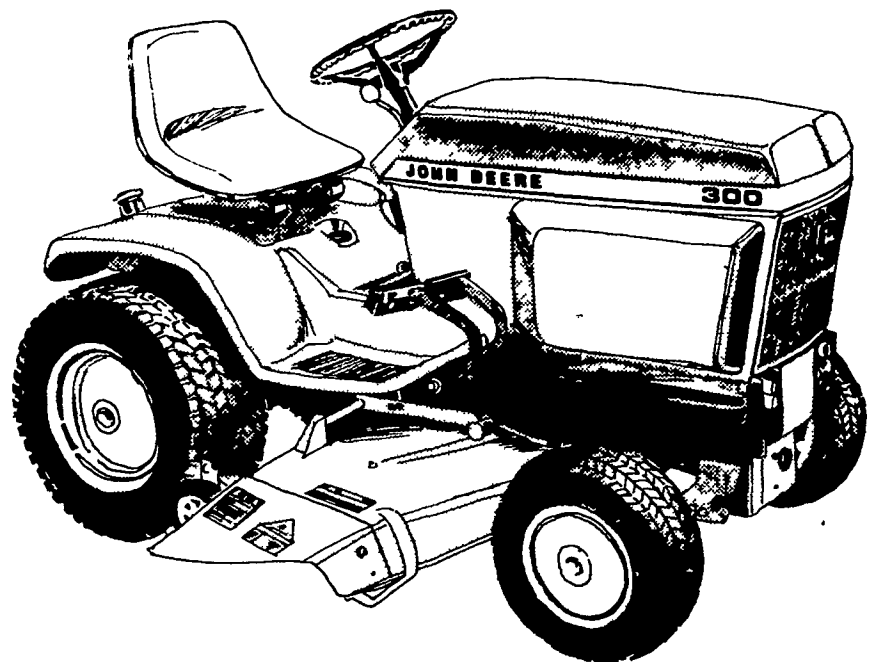
