CHESTER

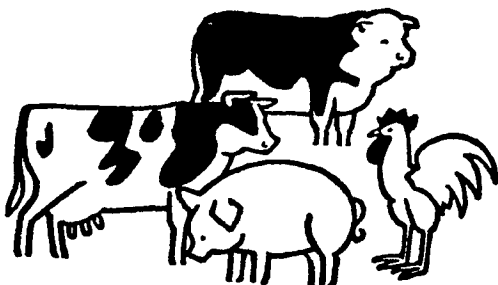
