other by the colonists at distances up to a quarter of a mile.

Now racing has grown in this country to become the number one spectator sport. During 1974, Quarter Horses competed for over \$18 million in purses at over 100 tracks throughout the United States. Pari-mutuel

wagering on Quarter Horse races was an astounding \$173 million, up nearly \$10 million from the previous year.

Equally popular in the Quarter Horse industry are approved shows and performance events for both youth and adults. Over 3000 of them were held in 1974 and 500,000 entries participated. While the parent AQHA has a membership of over 75,000, the American Junior

Quarter Horse Association lists 5700 members.

Surprised? Statistics don't lie, so don't be shocked if a son or daughter soon pops the question, "Can I get a horse?"

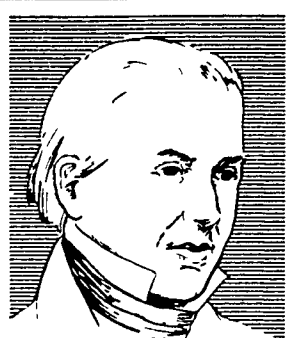

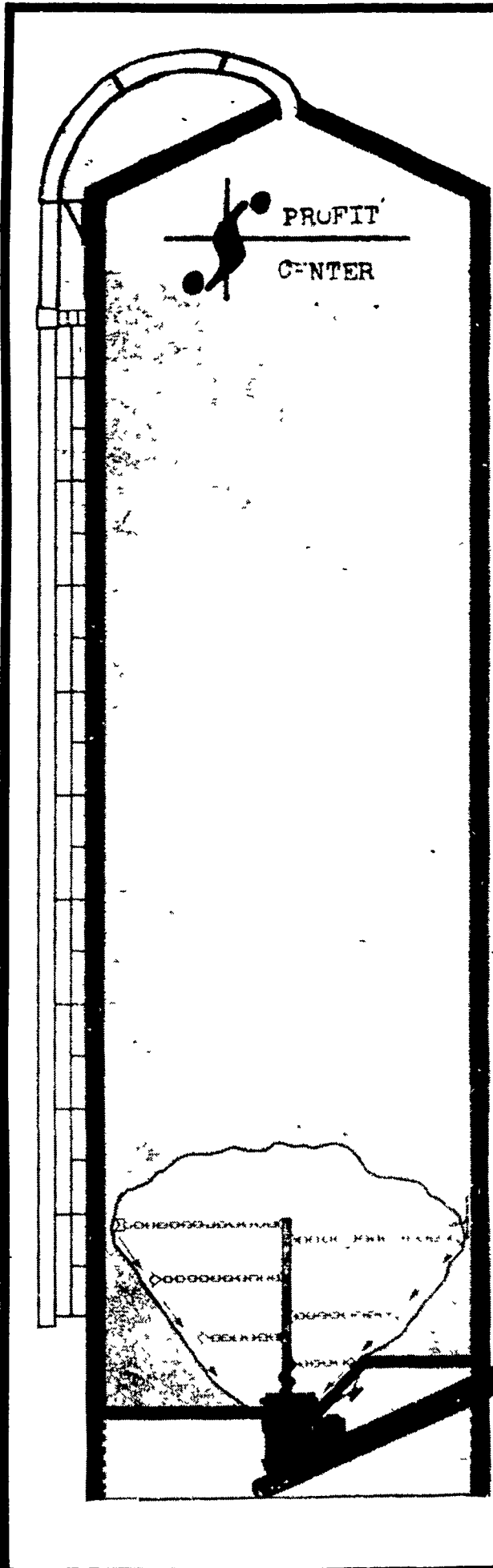

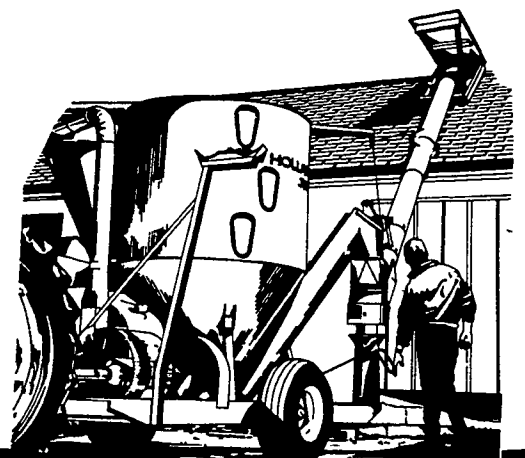
