Tax Meeting Scheduled by Garden Spot Adult Farmers

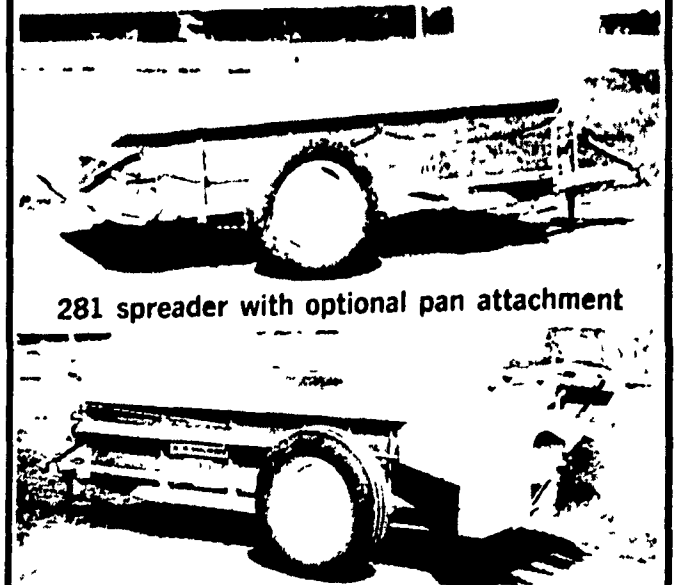

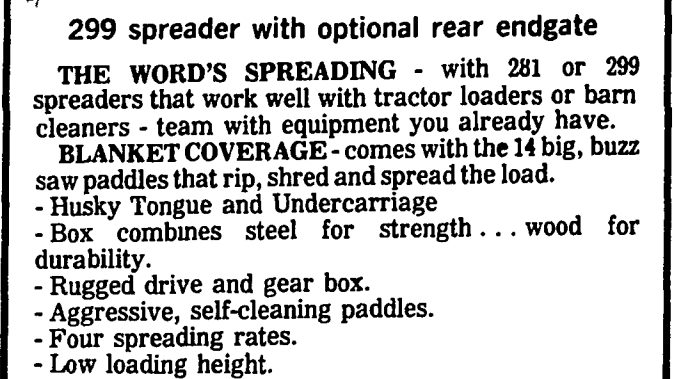
