

## **YORK** DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

January 1975

1045 lbs. of fat and 21,648 lbs. milk was produced in 305 days by Bertie, a registered holstein owned by Sinking Spring Farm to top the month production list. Ivy, another registered holstein owned by David Stewart, Delta R1, was second with 21,534 lbs. milk and 969 lbs. fat. The high herd for January was on 67.3 cows owned by Sinking Spring Farm, York R5, with 52.8 lbs. milk and 2.23 lbs. B.F. daily. The next high herd was that of David Stewart, Delta R1, on 56.3 cows producing 49.9 lbs. of milk and 2.02 lbs. of B.F. daily.


