Judges for the contest will be recipients of the Clyde N. Hall award since 1954. The Hall award is given each year to the high individual on the Penn State Dairy Cattle Judging Team.

FFA contestants will give two oral reasons, 4-H contestants will give three reasons, and professionals will give five oral reasons for their selections. Teams of four members will compete in each class. The three highest scores of each team will be used in score evaluation.

The Penn State Dairy Exposition will include a Dairy PRINCESS Contest on Aprıl 23 and will be climaxed with "show day" on May 3. Events of May 3 will include a dairy cattle fitting and showing contest, a celebrity milking contest, a sorority milking contest, a fraternity milk "chugging" contest, and a calf dressing contest.


