



The largest Maryland based milk marketing cooperative, the MCMP marketed more than 560,000,000 pounds of milk in 1974 valued at more than \$50 million. Its membership of 960 dairymen comes from all parts of Maryland and adjacent areas of Pennsylvania, Virginia and West Virginia.
