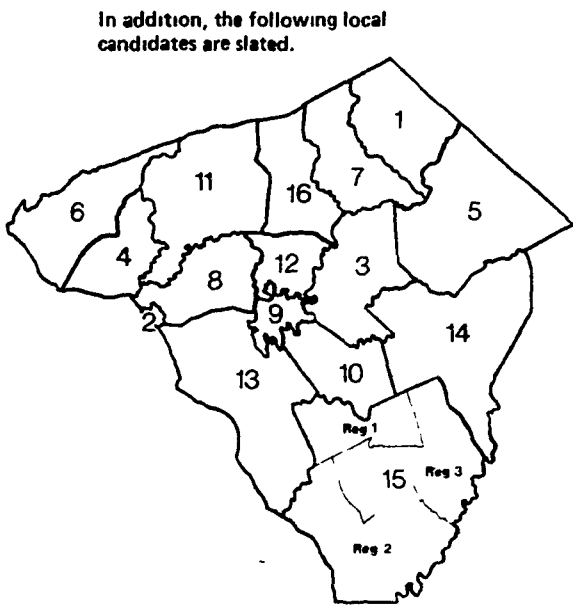
**Raymond G. Herr**
