The Rutts also enjoy a number of dairy foods although the most popular seems to be Cracker Pudding. Mrs. Rutt's recipe follows:

### Cracker Pudding

- 1 quart milk
- 2 eggs
- 1 cup coarse cracker crumbs
- ¾ cup sugar
- ¾ cups coconut
- vanilla

Scald milk and cracker crumbs. Mix together sugar, coconut and eggs. Add to milk mixture and bring to a boil. Add vanilla.

The Bixler's who farm in partnership with Mr. Bixler's father, are currently milking about 60 cows. Their farm is located at Marietta R1 near Maytown.

Sewing is one of her favorite pastimes as she makes not only clothes for her children, Jodi 7 and Jon 5 but also for her husband.

Mr. Bixler is a member of the Elizabethtown Young Farmers and belongs to the area Jaycees.

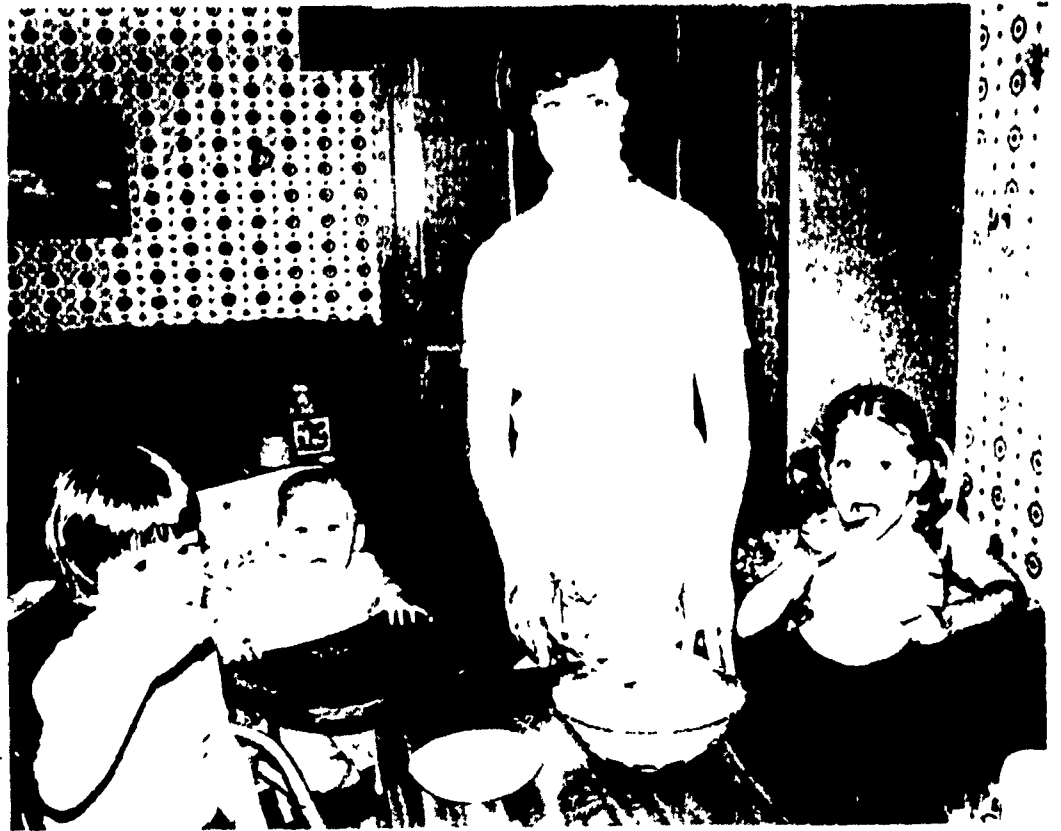
"Jay enjoys being on the farm and working with cows," Mrs. Bixler stated. "We do have other enterprises such as chickens and tobacco but dairying will always be his favorite."

Milk is the favorite dairy product around the Bixler household especially during the summer. However, one of the children's favorite is Chocolate pudding. Mrs. Bixler shares her recipe for pudding below:

### Chocolate Layer Pudding

Prepare 1 large package of pudding mix (cooked type) and layer in parfait glasses with whipped topping. Garnish with cherries and serve with tall glasses of milk.

**Homeowners cut mowing time in half with commercial rider**
