The public is invited to attend the event and to help in the promotion of dairy products.

Students Visit Witmer Farm

On May 28 and 29 the Garden Spot FFA Chapter of Lampeter-Strasburg High School treated the first grade students from Strasburg, Lampeter, and Willow Street elementary schools to a visit at the farm of J. Rohrer Witmer, Willow Street R2.

The FFA members explained the different aspects of farming, while children learned how a cow is milked by machine and then had the opportunity of milking a cow

by hand. They learned how milk is cooled and stored in a bulk tank. During a tour of the calf barn, some of the children were delighted when they helped feed milk from a bottle to the small calves. Along the educational tour there were pigs to observe and pet, also chicks to pet and hold. Further on the tour the operation of a tractor was explained along with the different skills of farming.
