Lancaster County 4-H Demonstration and Public Speaking Contest will be held July 1, 1975 at 1:00 p.m. at the Lancaster Farm and Home Center. This competition is open to all 4-H members who have completed one year in 4-H Club work. By giving demonstrations 4-H'ers can tell others what they have learned from their projects.

There will be Junior (8-13 yrs) and Senior (14-19 yrs) Divisions in the Demonstration and Public Speaking Contest. Junior Demonstrations are 7-10 minutes in length, with Senior Demonstrations 10-15 minutes. The Junior Division of Public Speaking is 3-5 minutes and Senior Public Speaking contestants must

speaking 5-7 minutes.

Winners will be chosen in all categories with Regional Competition being held July 11, 1975 at Northern High School, Dillsburg, Pa. Regional winners will participate at 4-H State Achievement Days at the Pennsylvania State University August 11-13, 1975. Each county will send the highest scoring boy and girl public speakers directly to State Days Competition.
