

Lime Up Now . . . to maintain high alfalfa yields and stretch your fertilizer dollar next year.

Liming alfalfa ground now maintains the pH level necessary for continued high alfalfa yields. And on sod, going into corn or alfalfa next year, it provides time for the lime to raise pH to the point

where you can get the highest return from the fertilizer you apply.

It's a good time to spread and Agway trucks are ready to roll. If you don't have a soil test to guide you, bring a representative soil sample (one pint) to Agway for a quick, free pH check. Then get that lime put down.
